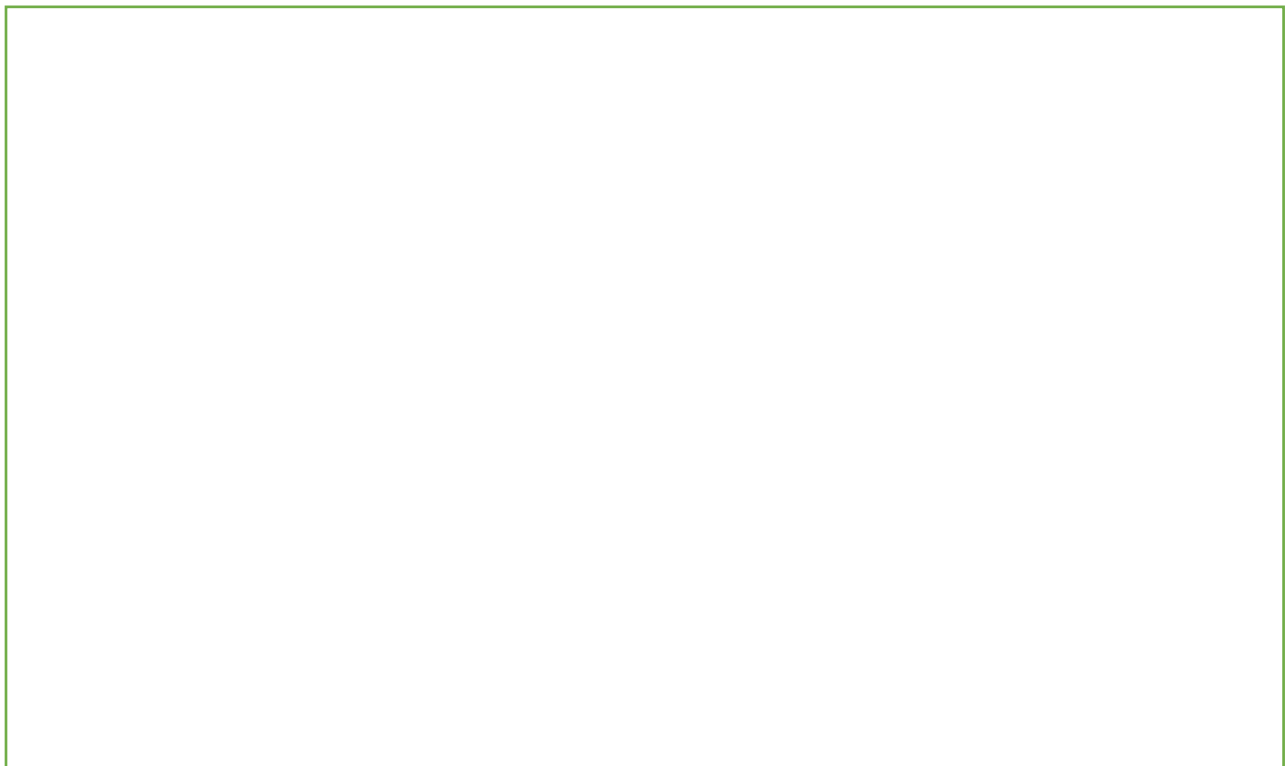

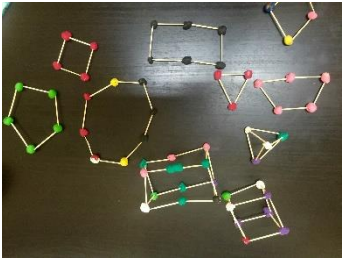

TIME FOR SPECIAL PLAY

Here are some fun ways you can make play time special

You don't need fancy toy's Be creative !



- Clay or chapathi dough and a few toothpicks
- Allow your child to lead the play activity
- Involve them in cooking and Baking

- Pipe cleaners and any basket or vessel with holes



- Read a book with them.
- Give them chores to do and appreciate them

on completion

- Build a fort with pillows and bedspreads.
- Have a family dance off



- Make a Scrap book

(A few sheets of colored or white paper stapled together. Make the children collect pictures from magazines, newspaper or really photographs. Make them cut and paste in the scrap book. Children can label the pictures. They can also draw pictures)

HOW TO MAKE PLAY DOUGH

Take 1 cup of maida flour and $\frac{1}{2}$ of powdered salt, 1 table spoon of cooking oil and any food coloring e.g. turmeric. Mix all the ingredients well together and then keep adding a little water at a time to make it into a chapati dough consistency. Use this clay for the children to mould into artistic items. When not in use the dough can be preserved in a plastic cover and refrigerated



Now tips for some painting activities

Thumb printing

Ask children to make thumb prints on paper with paint or ink .Help them to draw features.



wax resist- fish in water

Show the children to draw a fish with candle wax or yellow/orange crayon on the paper. Then make them take watery blue paint and paint the whole page, this will give effect of rainwater.

Blow painting

Make children place a few drops Of paint on the paper and blow on the paint with the drinking straw, the paint will spread and make beautiful designs.



Wet on wet

Make the children paint the whole paper with only water, then help them to take different colored powders and sprinkle them on the wet paper.

Soap bubble painting

Make the children color the water and add soap powder to it. Then make them blow bubbles through the straw and then onto the paper.

The bubbles will break and make pretty bubble patterns on paper



Thread Painting

Show the children how to roll thread around a pencil and to paint the thread with a paint brush.

Then show them how to roll the pencil on the paper to get impressions of the thread.

Homemade paint: Any colored rangoli powder, mixed with an equal quantity of glue or Maida paste and water will make a good paint to be used in any painting activity
